## **LGA**

In Maths, we have been learning to multiply and divide. In our Maths groups, we learnt to divide or share different amounts into groups; we used playdough to show our working. It was so much fun!



#### **LGB**

Science Investigation: Popping popcorn As a class, we cooked some popcorn in a microwave.

Firstly we looked at an uncooked kernel, measured, drew and labelled it. Then, we predicted what we thought would happen when a kernel is cooked in a microwave. We talked about what we could hear, see and smell. When the popcorn cooled, look at one piece; measure, draw and label it. We learnt that- Heat energy changes things. The heat produced in the microwave caused the kernel to open and expand (get bigger), changing it into popcorn.



#### **LGC**

LGC has been learning drama skills with Tara for the first five weeks of Term 3. They have played a variety of fun and exciting games, including a campfire skit. Students finished with a play script, where they dressed up and performed it in front of the rest of the class.




