# **Child Safety**



The new Child Safe Standards were enacted in July 2022 and are vital to what we do here at St Joseph's. What do these standards look like in practice? Each week, we will look at a standard in closer detail.

Standard 6 - People working with children and young people are suitable and supported to reflect child safety and wellbeing values in practice.

All school staff at St Joseph's are inducted by the school principal and are required to complete relevant documentation, show copies of their VIT, WWCC and police checks. They will complete training which will be outlined in the professional development plan created by the DOBCEL, Western Trinity or a network of schools. Upon arrival all contractors, volunteers and third parties will be asked to sign in and out of the school via the main office and will be asked to show a copy of their ID to ensure child safety.



All bus travellers need to ensure that everyone stays safe on our school bus. Our school provides supervision by staff members of bus travellers at drop off and pick up times at school.
