

Supervision of Students - Information for Parents

The School opens at 8.30am

The first bell for the day is at 8.55am to remind students and teachers that it is time to organise themselves for a day of teaching and learning. Students assemble on the basketball court for short assessemby then move to their classrooms ensure that they are ready to start working.

Punctuality, whilst an important life skill, is vital to assist good learning. The bell to indicate the start of learning time sounds at 8.55am. It is expected that all students have arrived in plenty of time so that instruction time is not lost during the most productive time of the day.

Supervision is provided by members of staff for students from 8.30am until 3.45pm.

Staff are on duty at recess and lunch times

Recess - 10.40am - 11.00am

Lunch 12.50pm - 1.10pm

No child is to leave school before the dismissal bell unless permission has been granted. In these circumstances the student/s need to be signed out in the register at the Office.

Students that travel by bus are met by a staff member and walked to the bus zone, where they are supervised until the bus arrives. All students departing the school are ticked off prior to leaving the school site.
